## BILL COSBY SEXUAL ASSAULT VICTIM SUES FOR DEFAMATION

## First of its kind lawsuit will allow Cosby victims to have claims heard in court Press conference TODAY with plaintiff and Washington, DC attorney

Washington, DC— A woman who claims she was sexually assaulted by comedian Bill Cosby in the 1970s has filed a lawsuit against him for defamation. The defamation suit presents a first of its kind opportunity for the plaintiff, as well as other alleged victims of Cosby's assault, to have a forum to litigate their claims.

The case will be discussed at a press conference TODAY, Wednesday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, at 3 PM.

Tamara Green, the plaintiff, has shared her story in the media beginning in 2005, with an appearance on the Today Show and in the *Philadelphia Inquirer*. Recently, she was mentioned in a *Washington Post* feature on the Cosby allegations. Since her 2005 media appearances, Cosby has, through his publicist and lawyer, branded Green – as well as other women who claim they were sexually assaulted by Cosbyaliar.

Washington, DC-based trial attorney Joseph Cammarata, who represented Paula Jones in her sexual harassment suit against President Bill Clinton in the late 1990s, represents Green in this new case. Green resides in California, but will participate in the press conference via videoconference.

Both Green and Cammarata will discuss their new lawsuit, which was filed this morning.
